## TOILETS FINALLY OPEN



I am really thrilled to announce that the first of our new toilet facilities have been opened in the Canteen area and are available for student use.

The toilet projects in the College are the first of our 10 Year Property Plan projects and completion of the Canteen toilets cost \$325,212 with the Social Science and Maths toilets that are due for completion for next term costing \$307,788 and the Board funding the final toilet renovation in the technology block to the tune of \$50,000.

This substantial investment in providing appropriate facilities has been a long-time project for Board member Karen Shepherd and as the now Resource Committee chairperson, it is with a sense of relief and satisfaction that finally these projects can make a real difference for our students.

We expect that this will also mean that the new facilities are afforded the respect that they deserve and that our students will show their support and consideration for others by maintaining our values in their use of the facilities.
