Principal's Message

Kia ora e te Whānau.

My thanks to those that attended last night's talk from Rob Cope on Cyber Safety and keeping our kids safe online. The Kāhui Ako was thrilled to have approximately 250 parents and caregivers turn up to engage with this kaupapa.

What I took away from the evening as a parent was my need to be engaging with the online activities of my children. To be talking to them about their online experiences that when we look at the statistics are likely to involve some very unsafe and predatory behaviours. It also reminded me that adolescent brains need our support, guidance, and boundaries when it comes to the perils of social media, online behaviour, and things like the proliferation of pornography and harmful internet content. The challenge is to disconnect to reconnect with our children so that as parents we can assist in keeping them safe.

Free dental care! Yes, we are about the have the Dental Clinic bus return to Naenae College - probably early next term. This is a wonderful opportunity for students and families, that's right, AND FAMILIES, to access dental care. For those meeting the criteria, this will be free. Dental health is such an important aspect of overall well-being and so important for ongoing health that I urge you to keep an eye on this opportunity.

Violence and drug use have been in the media recently and we are not immune from it. In our post-COVID environment, we especially need to exercise our value of manaakitanga when feelings of frustration develop. We want our community to be free of verbal and physical violence and have good support for those feeling overwhelmed. Emotional regulation is a vital skill to develop.

I remind you that next week we have Academic Conferencing and a PPTA strike day on Thursday. While the school will be open for instruction, our Special Needs Unit will be closed and only a handful of staff will be on-site to supervise any students who do attend. I know this disruption is inconvenient but I support a better outcome for teacher pay and conditions negotiation. Great teachers do vital work here at Naenae College and are the key to the success of our rangatahi.

Next week will also see the start of building developments for the College so there will be some changes to where the Administration team is and we will keep you informed.




